

AMENDMENT #2  
to the  
ALABAMA SQUARE & ROUND DANCE ASSOCIATION  
BY-LAWS, Rev. No. 2, 20 Jan. 1990

This Amendment was approved by the ASARDA Board of Directors on 22 August 1992.

ARTICLE IV is amended as follows:

Section 1. No change.

Section 2. The ASARDA Board of Directors shall be composed of ASARDA Officers, District Delegates, Delegates to National Associations, Delegates from other Statewide Associations, Membership Coordinator, Editor, Insurance Chairman and Committee Chairmen.

(This change adds Membership Coordinator and deletes Education Director which is covered by "Committee Chairmen")

Section 3. For the purposes of composition of the Board of Directors, the State of Alabama has been divided into Districts, as recorded in Article II, with a minimum of three (3) Delegates from each District serving as voting members of the Board of Directors. These District Delegates shall be elected or appointed by the respective districts in accordance with their own District procedures. The term of office of the District Delegates will be determined by their representative District organization.

One additional non-voting District Delegate may be elected or appointed by the respective districts for every 100 ASARDA Members over 300 ASARDA Members in their District. The dancer count is based on the previous years membership depicted in the official ASARDA Membership Roster. These additional District Delegates will be a member of the Board of Directors without vote, elected or appointed by their respective districts in accordance with their own District procedures and for the term of office as determined by their representative District organization.

(This change deletes "District Council By-Laws" as only one District has a District Council. It also limits the District Delegates to three (3) voting Delegates for each District and permits additional non-voting District Delegates to assist in the administration of Districts with larger ASARDA membership)
