

Section 2. Current ASARDA Districts are:

- District 1 - North Alabama
- District 2 - North Central Alabama
- District 3 - (Merged with Districts 2 & 4)
- District 4 - South Central Alabama
- District 5 - Southwest Alabama
- District 6 - Southeast Alabama

ARTICLE III

Membership

Section 1. REGULAR MEMBERSHIP may be held by an Association, Club or individual Dancer participating in dance activities of the State of Alabama. Application for membership shall be by written request through the District Coordinator of the geographical district in which the association, club or dancer is located.

Section 2. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP may be held by an Association, Club or individual Dancer desiring to affiliate with the State Association. Application for membership shall be by written request through the adjacent District Coordinator of the geographical district nearest to where the dancer or dancer organization resides.

Section 3. HONORARY MEMBERSHIP shall be a person whom the State Association desires to honor for contributions to the support or growth of Square/Round/Contra/Clogging/Folk Dancing in the State of Alabama. Such honorary members need not be a dancer.

Section 4. DISTINGUISHED LIFE MEMBERSHIP shall be a Square/Round/Clogging/Contra/Folk Dancer or Caller/Instructor whom the Association desires to honor for exceptional contributions to the growth of Square/Round/Clogging/Contra/Folk Dancing in the State of Alabama.

Section 5. MEMBERSHIP DUES shall be determined by the ASARDA Board of Directors and made a matter of record.

Section 7. Dues are paid to the Alabama Square And Round Dance Association, Inc. Treasurer through the appropriate District Coordinator. Checks shall be made out to Alabama Square and Round Dance Association, Inc. or A.S.A.R.D.A., Inc. Additional special dues or increase in dues may be assessed by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

Section 8. Any Association, Club or individual Dancer whose dues are more than three (3) months in arrears shall be suspended from active ASARDA membership.

Section 9. A current registry of all classes of membership shall be kept by the Treasurer.

Section 10. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP. A member Association, Club or Dancer which fails to uphold or comply with the Articles of Incorporation or with the Constitution and By-Laws and/or the standing rules, or for other cause deemed sufficient, may be suspended or expelled by
