

hospitals, etc.

e. Providing information for coordinating activities of all square, round, contra, clogging and folk dance associations, clubs, etc. throughout Alabama. This includes functions such as state conventions, area festivals, special dance dates, charities, benefits, and other related activities.

f. Assisting, if possible, any association, club caller, teacher, instructor, dancer which have encountered problems and requests help.

g. Improving the social image of square, round, contra, clogging, folk dancing through acceptable publicity and practices.

h. Increasing the social strength of square, round, contra, clogging, folk dance organizations, through the effects of a collective, unified body.

i. Qualifying Alabama to host a National Convention.

j. Promoting and maintaining standards which will keep the activity on a high social level above approach.

k. Conducting an Annual State Convention.

l. Acting as a liaison for the Alabama dancers with National Organizations and other State Organizations.

ARTICLE III

Government

Section 1. The government and management of the Association shall be vested in a Board of Directors.

Section 2. Officers and Delegates shall be selected as provided in the By-Laws of the Association, as now or hereafter adopted, and they shall have and exercise only such powers as may be provided in said By-Laws.

ARTICLE IV

Membership

Section 1. Membership in this Association shall be open to all Associations, Clubs, Individual Square, Round, Contra, Clogging and Folk Dancers, Callers, Teachers, Cuers, Prompters, and Instructors that are involved in the Alabama dance activity.

Section 2. Classes of Membership are as specified in the Association By-Laws.

Section 3. There shall be an annual meeting of the Association membership to be held at the time, date, and place as specified in the Association By-Laws. Regular and special meetings may be called as
