ARTICLE V

Liquor & Gambling

Section 1. The Association shall have no right to engage in and it will not engage in the selling or keeping for sale or otherwise dispose of any liquors, liquids or beverages that are prohibited by the Laws of Alabama to be manufactured, sold or otherwise disposed of in this State; and said Association shall not permit its members to keep or store any such prohibited liquors or beverages at or near the premises of the Corporation for use by or consumption by its members or others for distribution or dividing among its members or its guests, and that said Association will not maintain any unlawful drinking place or any liquor nuisance contrary to the Laws of Alabama.


Section 2. This Association shall not permit any game to be played for wager or any gambling or the presence of any gambling devices on, or about the premises.

ARTICLE VI

Amendments

Section 1. Amendments to this Constitution may be made at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors by an affirmative vote of two thirds (2/3) of the authorized voting members present, provided that notice of the proposed amendment was submitted at a previous meeting or by mail at least 30 days prior to the regular meeting.
